I, Daniel T. Satterberg, Prosecuting Attorney for King County in the name and by the authority of the State of Washington, do accuse KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS of the following crime[s], which are based on the same conduct or a series of acts connected together or constituting parts of a common scheme or plan: **Animal Cruelty in the First Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment - Domestic Violence, Assault In The Second Degree - Domestic Violence, Attempted Extortion In The First Degree, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order, Assault In The Fourth Degree - Domestic Violence, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order,** committed as follows:

**Count 1 - Animal Cruelty in the First Degree**

That the defendants Matthew John Grabousky and KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, between May 1, 2017 and May 31, 2017 , did knowingly engage in sexual conduct or sexual contact with an animal to-wit: a dog; did knowingly photograph or film, for purposes of sexual gratification, a person engaged in a sexual act or sexual contact with an animal to-wit: a dog;

Contrary to RCW 16.52.205(3), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

And further do allege the defendants, Matthew John Grabowsky AKA Matthew John Grabousky and KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS of commission of this crime with sexual

1 motivation, that is: that one of the purposes for which the defendant committed this crime was  
2 for the purpose of his sexual gratification, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

3 **Count 2 - Unlawful Imprisonment - Domestic Violence**

4 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about  
5 March 8, 2017, did knowingly restrain R.S. (DOB 10/26/93), a human being by knowingly  
6 restricting that person's movements in a manner that interfered substantially with his or her  
7 liberty, knowing that the restriction was without consent and knowing that the restriction was  
8 without legal authority;

9 Contrary to RCW 9A.40.010(6); RCW 9A.40.040, and against the peace and dignity of  
10 the State of Washington.

11 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
12 the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
13 under RCW 10.99.020.

14 **Count 3 - Assault In The Second Degree - Domestic Violence**

15 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about July  
16 27, 2017, with intent to inflict bodily harm, did administer to and cause to be taken by R.S. (10-  
17 26-1993), a poison and a destructive or noxious substance, to-wit: pineapple juice, of which RS  
18 is severely allergic;

19 Contrary to RCW 9A.36.021(1)(d), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
20 Washington.

21 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
22 the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
23 under RCW 10.99.020.

24 And further do allege the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards of commission of this crime  
with sexual motivation, that is: that one of the purposes for which the defendant committed this  
crime was for the purpose of his sexual gratification, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

**Count 4 - Attempted Extortion In The First Degree**

That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about July  
27, 2017, did knowingly attempt to obtain and did knowingly obtain services, to-wit: sexual  
intercourse, from the owner, R.S.(DOB 10-26-1993), by means of a threat that communicated  
directly or indirectly the intent to cause bodily injury in the future to the person threatened or to  
any other person; attempt as used in the above charge means that the defendant committed an act  
which was a substantial step towards the commission of the above described crime with the  
intent to commit that crime;

1  
2 Contrary to RCW 9A.28.020 and 9A.56.110, 9A.56.120 and 9A.04.110(28)(a)(b)(c), and  
3 against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

4 And further do allege the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards of commission of this crime  
5 with sexual motivation, that is: that one of the purposes for which the defendant committed this  
6 crime was for the purpose of his sexual gratification, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

7 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
8 the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW  
9 9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).

10 **Count 5 - Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order**

11 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about  
12 August 25, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on August  
13 24, 2017 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99, for the protection of  
14 R.S. (DOB 10/26/1993);

15 Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
16 Washington.

17 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
18 the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
19 under RCW 10.99.020.

20 **Count 6 - Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order**

21 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about  
22 August 27, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on August  
23 24, 2017 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99, for the protection of  
24 R.S. (10-26-1993);

Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
Washington.

And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
under RCW 10.99.020.

**Count 7 - Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order**

That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about  
August 28, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on August

1 24, 2017 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99, for the protection of  
2 R.S. (10-26-1993);

3 Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
4 Washington.

5 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
6 the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
7 under RCW 10.99.020.

8  
9 **Count 8 - Assault In The Fourth Degree - Domestic Violence**

10 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about May  
11 1, 2017, did intentionally assault Rebekah Scott;

12 Contrary to RCW 9A.36.041(1), (2), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
13 Washington.

14 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
15 the above crime against a family or household member, a crime of domestic violence as defined  
16 in RCW 9A.36.041(4) (intimate partner) and RCW 10.99.020.


17 **Count 9 - Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order**

18 That the defendant Kevin Allen Richards in King County, Washington, on or about May  
19 1, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on August 24, 2017  
20 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99 and RCW chapter 26.50, for  
21 the protection of Rebekah Scott;

22 Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
23 Washington.

24 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
the above crime against a family or household member; a crime of domestic violence as defined  
under RCW 10.99.020.

3 CERTIFICATION FOR DETERMINATION OF PROBABLE CAUSE

4  
5 That Tai Wotherspoon is a (n) POLICE OFFICER with the BELLEVUE POLICE  
6 DEPARTMENT and has reviewed the investigation conducted in BELLEVUE POLICE  
7 DEPARTMENT Case Number: 17-47952

8  
9 There is probable cause to believe that Kevin A Richards (01-16-1993) committed the crime(s) of:

10  
11 **RCW 10.99.040 (4) No Contact Order Violation**

12  
13 This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

14  
15  
16 On September 7, 2017, at approximately 2016 hours, I responded to a domestic call at the Liv  
17 Apartments, 15566 NE 22nd Pl #753. Dispatch had advised that the victim was not free to talk  
18 and was trying to get to a safe location. Dispatch was able to obtain that the caller, victim  
19 Rebekah Scott, has a no contact order with suspect Kevin Richards. Richards was currently at  
20 the location in violation of the order.

21  
22 Victim Scott met me in the lobby of the apartment. Corporal Bruchon, Officer McKinney, and  
23 Officer Castellanos responded to the apartment with me to make contact with Richards.  
24 Richards was gone upon our arrival.

25  
26 I spoke with Scott about the incident. Scott said Richards and her were in a dating relationship  
27 and lived together until Richards was arrested for DV assault on August 24. When Richards' was  
28 released he was advised of the no contact order. Scott said they continued to communicate via  
29 "chat" on her phone but had no records of it due to it being able to be deleted by either party.  
30 Scott said since the order they have communicated in some fashion everyday and she has seen  
31 him approximately twelve times. Scott states their communications have been regarding her  
32 getting a new place so he can go back to his residence. Scott said she has told him he is allowed  
33 to come over to shower and get things when she is at work but he comes over when she is home  
34 as well.

35  
36 Scott said during today's incident, she was in the kitchen of the apartment when Richards walked  
37 in at approximately 1945 hours. Richards still has a key and FOB to enter the location. Scott  
38 said Richards was with his friend, "Sebastian." Scott and Richards went into their old bedroom  
39 and discussed Scott's living arrangement. Scott said Richards began to get angry that she had not  
40 moved and did not have a place yet. Scott feared for her safety due to him getting angry and  
41 asked him to leave. Scott said she told him numerous times, "You need to go." Richards began  
42 to taunt her about calling the police and saying she would not do it. Richards even told her she  
43 was pretending to call 911 so that he would leave. Scott was finally able to walk away from  
44 Richards and wait in the lobby for police. Scott noticed after she left the apartment that Richards  
45 had sent a message asking if he could come over but she had never seen it. Scott said it was not  
46 physical today and has not been since his arrest.

47  
48 Scott did not know where he has been staying or where he may have gone. Officers checked the  
49 area but did not locate him.

50

1 Corporal Bruchon spoke with a roommate, witness Benjamin Gallup. Gallup stated that  
2 Richards was at the apartment prior to police arrival while Scott was there. Gallup said Richards  
3 stayed for approximately 20-30 minutes. Gallup stated he has seen Richards at the apartment  
4 twice to pick up belongings.  
5

6 I spoke with Richards via telephone and he refused to meet with me in person or tell me where  
7 he was. Richards stated he had received an email from his apartment complex about him being  
8 evicted effective today, September 7. Richards said due to this notice he assumed Scott would  
9 not be there. Richards said Scott continues to send him messages but he does not respond so he  
10 did not know her status. After work, Richards went to the apartment to get his belongings.  
11 Richards said that Scott was there and that he only stayed for approximately five minutes.  
12 Richards said he was aware of the no contact order and stated he did not know she would be  
13 there and just was getting his stuff since he assumed everyone was gone due to the eviction. I  
14 asked Richards about sending Scott a message prior to responding to the location, which he  
15 denied. Richards did not have anything further to add.  
16

17 The preceding occurred in the City of Bellevue, County of King, State of Washington.  
18

19 Under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington, I certify that the foregoing

**CASE REPORT****NARRATIVE****Call:**

On 08/24/2017 at approximately 0330 hours I was dispatched to an Unwanted Subject call at the Liv Apartments, 15566 NE 22<sup>nd</sup> PL 753. The reporting party, Kevin A. Richards 01/16/1993, stated his ex-girlfriend, Rebekah N. Scott, was in his room and she would not get out.

**Scene:**

Officer Berns and I arrived on scene and contacted Richards. Richards stated Scott and him broke up a few weeks ago, but were still living together. Richards stated Scott and he had an argument and she was now refusing to leave his room. Richards stated he tried to take her dog into the den where Scott was supposed to be sleeping. Scott locked herself in his room and refused to get out. Richards forced his way into the room. Richards stated Scott stood in his way and he grabbed her around the waist put her on the ground in order to get by her. When Richards put her on the ground Scott stated "Ouch". Scott then locked herself in the bathroom. Richards called 911.

Richards stated he did not put her on the ground hard and he was only trying to get her out of the way to get into his room. Richards took us up the apartment to talk to Scott.

**Victim Statement:**

When we arrived in the apartment Scott was still locked in the bathroom. Scott opened the door when I announced we were the police. When Scott opened the door her eyes were puffy and red and tears were coming from her eyes.

Scott stated Richards and she had an argument after their friend Matthew left the apartment. Scott said Matthew and Richards were trying to pay her to have sex with them. Scott showed me text messages of them offering up to \$500 "to smash". Scott stated she refused and Richards became upset. After Matthew left the apartment Scott said the argument got worse. Scott tried to go to bed, but Richards told her that she could not sleep in their bed. Richards called their friend Brandon Ong and talked about the situation with him. Scott moved to the spare room. Ong then called Scott to get her side of story. Scott was on the phone with Ong when Richards came in and began arguing with her about the mutual dog they had together. Richards threatened to throw the dog off the balcony. Scott began to yell at Richards and then ran into their room and locked the door. Richards got a key for the door and Scott tried to hold it shut, but Richards forced his way in. Scott stated she was hit by the door. Scott moved out of the way and stood near the wall in the bedroom. Richards grabbed Scott by the shoulders and threw her to the ground. While Scott was on the ground she covered her head with her arms as Richards was yelling at her and slapping her arms that were blocking her face. Richards was yelling "look what you did". Scott yelled back "you are hurting me", "don't hit me". Scott stated the hitting stopped and she went into the bathroom and locked the door. Scott provided a written statement.

**NARRATIVE (continuation)**

While Scott was telling me about the incident, tears continued to roll down her face and stated she is scared of what Richards could do to her. Scott was visibly shaking as she told me about the incident. Scott stated she was not injured during the incident and did not complain on any pain. Scott again stated she was scared and did not know what else to do. Scott did not call 911 because she heard Richards already on the phone and she was scared if she called he would break through the bathroom door.

Scott stated Ong was on the phone during the whole incident. I spoke with Ong the phone and he stated it was hard to tell what was going on, but he could hear Richards yelling at Scott. Ong could also hear Scott yell "stop hitting me" and "don't hit me".

Based on Scott's statements and her being visibly scared I determined there to be probable cause to arrest Richards for DV Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree. I contacted Richards again and advised him he was under arrest for DV Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree. I handcuffed Richards, checking for fit and double locking them. I escorted Richards to Officer Berns patrol vehicle. Officer Berns transported and booked Richards into Issaquah City Jail.

Disposition:

Case closed by arrest.

I tried to diffuse the situation by going to bed to which he replied I could not sleep in the bed, because the bed that we got during our relationship is his. He then called my friend Brandon Ong. They talked it out while I moved to the spare bedroom. I was in the spare bedroom when I received a call from Brandon Ong because he wanted to hear "my side of the story" I was on the phone for just a few minutes when I heard the baby gate open, (to the spare room) I told Kevin to just go to bed, and that I would put the dogs on that


