I, Daniel T. Satterberg, Prosecuting Attorney for King County in the name and by the authority of the State of Washington, do accuse KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS of the following crime[s], which are based on the same conduct or a series of acts connected together or constituting parts of a common scheme or plan: **Animal Cruelty in the First Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment , Assault In The Second Degree - Domestic Violence, Attempted Extortion In The First Degree, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order, Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order**, committed as follows:

Count 1 Animal Cruelty in the First Degree –

That the defendant MATTHEW JOHN GRABOUSKY AND KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, between May 1, 2017 and May 31, 2017 , did knowingly engage in sexual conduct or sexual contact with an animal to-wit: a dog; did knowingly photograph or film, for purposes of sexual gratification, a person engaged in a sexual act or sexual contact with an animal to-wit: a dog, and that KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS did knowingly caused, aided or abetted another person to engage in sexual contact with an animal, to wit: a dog.

Contrary to RCW 16.52.205(3), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

And further do allege the defendant, Matthew John Grabowsky AKA Matthew John Grabousky of commission of this crime with sexual motivation, that is: that one of the purposes

1 for which the defendant committed this crime was for the purpose of his sexual gratification,  
2 under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

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Count 2 Unlawful Imprisonment - Domestic Violence

That the defendant KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, on or about March 8, 2017, did knowingly restrain R.S. (DOB 10/26/93), a human being by knowingly restricting that person's movements in a manner that interfered substantially with his or her liberty, knowing that the restriction was without consent and knowing that the restriction was without legal authority;

Contrary to RCW 9A.40.010(6); RCW 9A.40.040, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW 9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).

Count 3 Assault In The Second Degree - Domestic Violence

That the defendant KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, on or about July 27, 2017, with intent to inflict bodily harm, did administer to and cause to be taken by R.S. (10-26-1993), a poison and a destructive or noxious substance, to-wit: pineapple juice, of which RS is severly allergic;;

Contrary to RCW 9A.36.021(1)(d), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW 9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).

And further do allege the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards of commission of this crime with sexual motivation, that is: that one of the purposes for which the defendant committed this crime was for the purpose of his sexual gratification, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

Count 4 Attempted Extortion In The First Degree

That the defendant KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, on or about July 27, 2017, did knowingly attempt to obtain and did knowingly obtain services, to-wit: sexual intercourse, from the owner, R.S.(DOB 10-26-1993), by means of a threat that communicated directly or indirectly the intent to cause bodily injury in the future to the person threatened or to any other person; attempt as used in the above charge means that the defendant

1 committed an act which was a substantial step towards the commission of the above described  
2 crime with the intent to commit that crime;

3 Contrary to RCW 9A.28.020 and 9A.56.110, 9A.56.120 and 9A.04.110(28)(a)(b)(c), and  
4 against the peace and dignity of the State of Washington.

5 And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
6 the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW  
7 9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).

8 And further do allege the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards of commission of this crime  
9 with sexual motivation, that is: that one of the purposes for which the defendant committed this  
10 crime was for the purpose of his sexual gratification, under the authority of RCW 9.94A.835.

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Count 5 Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order

That the defendant KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, on or  
about August 25, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on  
August 24, 2017 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99, for the  
protection of R.S. (DOB 10/26/1993);

Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
Washington.

And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW  
9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).

Count 6 Domestic Violence Misdemeanor Violation Of A Court Order

That the defendant KEVIN ALLEN RICHARDS in King County, Washington, on or  
about August 27, 2017, did know of and willfully violate the terms of a court order issued on  
August 24, 2017 by the King County District Court pursuant to RCW chapter 10.99, for the  
protection of R.S. (10-26-1993);

Contrary to RCW 26.50.110(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of  
Washington.

And further do accuse the defendant, Kevin Allen Richards, at said time of committing  
the above crime of domestic violence against a family or household member as defined in RCW  
9A.36.041(4) (an intimate partner).



3 PROSECUTING ATTORNEY CASE SUMMARY AND REQUEST FOR BAIL AND/OR  
4 CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

5 The State incorporates by reference the Certification for Determination of Probable Cause  
6 prepared by Investigator Clarence Tolliver of the Renton Police Department for case number 17-  
7 11549.

8  
9 There have been no prior hearings on this matter. The State asks that the court set bail in this  
10 matter in the amount of \$400,000 as there is concern under Criminal Rule 2.2(b)(2)(i) and (ii)  
11 that the defendant will fail to appear and will commit a violent offense against the victim in this  
12 case.

13  
14 The certification for probable cause details the defendant has assaulted the victim previously on  
15 numerous times, has unlawfully imprisoned her multiple times, and has allegedly poisoned her to  
16 extort her for sexual intercourse. He has open cases of domestic violence out of King County  
17 District Court (Assault 4 and MVNCO). All of these assaults came prior to her coming forward  
18 with video and photographic evidence of the alleged animal cruelty. When he learned she had  
19 knowledge of the animal cruelty, he threatened to kill her if she told anyone. She came forward  
20 none the less, and the state is very concerned for the victim's safety as well as anyone else who  
21 may have knowledge of the crimes and the safety of animals in the community. The State has  
22 further concerns for flight risk based on the certification for probable cause information detailing  
23 the effort Richards' made to conceal his vehicle license plate "Noodles" to avoid arrest on these  
24 crimes as well as his refusal to follow court orders evidenced by the multiple violations of no



CERTIFICATION FOR THE DETERMINATION OF PROBABLE CAUSE

That C. Tolliver is an Investigator with the Renton Police Department and has reviewed the investigation conducted in Renton Police Department Case Number #2017-11549

There is probable Cause to believe that Kevin Allen Richards, born 01/16/1993, committed the crime of Animal Cruelty in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree (with Sexual Motivation and DV), RCW 16.52.205, Extortion in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree (with Sexual Motivation and DV), Assault in the Second Degree (with Sexual Motivation and DV) and Unlawful Imprisonment (DV) RCW 9A.40.060. This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances that occurred within the City Limits of Renton, in the County of King, and in the State of Washington:

Animal Cruelty in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree (with Sexual Motivation and DV), RCW 16.52.205

On 09/15/2017 at approximately 1155 hours, Renton Police Department Officer C. DesMet was dispatched to assist Animal Control Officer D. McAskill with an animal cruelty case that occurred at 2213 Duvall Ave NE, in the City of Renton, County of King, State of Washington. Upon arrival, AC McAskill informed Officer DesMet that the reporting party (who I will identify in this PC Cert RS due to the nature of the investigation) wanted to file a report of animal cruelty to her canine "Diamond", who is an 8 year old Siberian Husky

1 service dog. RS requests non-disclosure for fear of  
2 retaliation.

3  
4 AC McAskill gave me a synopsis of the call from speaking with  
5 RS. He advised that a suspect in this case, one of whom is  
6 her ex-boyfriend, has had access to her dog Diamond in the  
7 past. She identified her ex-boyfriend as Kevin A. Richards,  
8 DOB 1/16/1993. She also told McAskill that on about May 31,  
9 2017, while they were living in Bellevue, Richards told RS he  
10 was taking her dog "Diamond" to a rollerblade park. RS felt  
11 this was a good idea and good exercise for Diamond. On about  
12 August 19, 2017, she was contacted by a mutual friend of hers  
13 and Kevin and was informed that another mutual friend (Matthew  
14 Grabowsky, DOB 6/18/1991) was in a video having sexual  
15 intercourse with Diamond. RS did not actually see the  
16 recording until the evening of 09/14/17, at about 1811 hours.  
17 She observed a male that she recognized as Grabowsky on a  
18 video getting onto his hands and knees, nude, to engage in  
19 sexual acts with Diamond. The video shows Grabowsky being  
20 mounted by Diamond and anally penetrated by Diamond. RS  
21 clearly identified Grabowsky from prior knowledge of him and  
22 identified Diamond by facial markings and his service dog  
23 harness. RS also observed property of Grabowksy inside the  
24 garage, indicating that the act likely occurred in Grabowsky's  
25 residence in Washington. RS did not give Kevin permission to  
26 take Diamond to Grabowsky's house and she did not give  
27 Grabowsky permission to knowingly engage in sexual conduct  
28 with Diamond. Richards and Grabowsky organized, planned and  
29 coordinated the sexual act against Diamond without her  
30 knowledge. Richards aided Grabowsky in this crime by supplying



1 Diamond, transporting Diamond to Grabowsky, and then returning  
2 Diamond to his true owner after the crime.

3  
4 RS currently has a no contact order against Kevin from a  
5 domestic assault in Bellevue, WA that occurred on about  
6 08/24/17, which stemmed from Richards and Grabowsky attempting  
7 to coerce RS to have sex with them for money. She declined  
8 and was assaulted. Refer to Bellevue PD case #17-45052 for  
9 further information. RS believes this was to keep her from  
10 reporting them (Kevin and Grabowsky) and to make her a less  
11 than credible witness if she chose to report them. RS further  
12 informed Officer DesMet that Grabowsky claims to have sex with  
13 dogs to keep from having sex with female children. RS emailed  
14 Officer DesMet the video showing Grabowsky engaging in sexual  
15 conduct with her canine Diamond. Officer DesMet copied the  
16 video on a CD-ROM and submitted it with the case file.

17  
18 On 10/12/17, I called and spoke with RS about this case. She  
19 told me that Diamond is a service dog that assists her for her  
20 heart problems. She has previously had cardiac arrest in the  
21 past and the dog alerts her to dangerous changes in blood  
22 pressure.

23  
24 She said that Richards has been abusive to her in the past  
25 prior to her discovering that Grabowsky was having sex with  
26 Diamond. She said starting back in April (2017), Richards was  
27 pressuring her to have a threesome with him and Grabowsky but  
28 she refused. Ever since then, she said that Grabowsky has  
29 been pressuring her to have sex with him because according to  
30 him, she has the body of a "15 year-old" and that's what he's

1 attracted to. She went on to tell me, Grabowsky recently  
2 adopted two large dogs. He wanted RS to bring Diamond over to  
3 his house so that both of their dogs could have sex and he  
4 could masturbate to it.

5  
6 I asked her how she received the video of Grabowsky engaged in  
7 a sex act with her dog. She said she received it from a  
8 friend. He messaged RS saying that he found Diamond in a sex  
9 video. The friend described video and later sent it to her. I  
10 asked her how she knew that the incident occurred in  
11 Grabowsky's garage. She said she recognized the garage from  
12 photographs she had seen on Facebook of a party he threw at  
13 his house in the past. She told me that she and Richards broke  
14 up June 2017 because of an abusive situation. On 09/24/17,  
15 she confronted both Richards and Grabowsky at their apartment  
16 in Bellevue. Both Kevin and Grabowsky denied it occurred.  
17 Grabowsky kept saying someone was trying to frame him. RS  
18 then showed them a snippet of the video. They started blaming  
19 RS for the abuse of the dog, telling her that she should've  
20 had sex with them. They told her if she had permitted them to  
21 have sex with her then they would not have needed to have sex  
22 with her dog.

23  
24 Grabowsky told RS that he was into "this" (having sex with  
25 dogs). Grabowsky and Richards then wanted to pay her for sex.  
26 When she refused, they threatened to kill her, telling her "if  
27 you say anything to anyone about this, you're dead" (Richards  
28 said this to RS). Richards also made threats about throwing  
29 her dog off their balcony. When Grabowsky went to take  
30 shower, she and RS kept arguing. Richards made threats that

1 the police would take Diamond and euthanize him. She said she  
2 was freaking out and upset.

3  
4 She also told me that Grabowsky told her that he has other  
5 videos of him having sex with other dogs along with Diamond.  
6 He also threatened that if he goes down (meaning if he gets  
7 arrested) that Kevin would get arrested also because there are  
8 videos of him (Kevin) having sex with Diamond.

9  
10 RS began telling me about information that occurred before the  
11 DV Assault. She told me that a mutual friend of theirs  
12 witnessed Richards and her dog Diamond "having sex" when they  
13 resided at their old apartment (15566 NE 22nd Pl S-753,  
14 Bellevue 98007, the Liv Bel-Red Complex). On an unknown date,  
15 the mutual friend was walking past their apartment and he  
16 looked into RS bedroom window and saw Kevin and Diamond  
17 engaging in sexual acts.

18  
19 When I asked RS about Grabowsky, she said that she suspected  
20 that he was into being sexual with dogs. She told me about a  
21 time when she first got Diamond, he wanted to get a puppy. He  
22 explained that he wanted the dog to be about 1-2 year-old  
23 female and she had to have gone through her first heat cycle.  
24 RS assumed he was talking about for breeding purposes. But  
25 she later heard rumors that he was into having sex with dogs.

26  
27 RS was able to provide to me the videos she had received from  
28 a friend showing Grabowsky performing a sexual act with her  
29 dog. I have viewed this video to confirm the contents are  
30 what she purported them to be. The videos are of the inside

1 of a garage. Diamond, the dog can be seen in the video,  
2 wearing his service harness and walking around the garage.  
3 The second video shows the same dog. The footage contains a  
4 human male, and shows his face, which RS identified as  
5 Grabowsky. The male is nude and setting up an angle for the  
6 camera. The video shows the same animal, Diamond (a male  
7 husky type breed of dog) penetrate Grabowsky anally for an  
8 extended period of time (almost a minute).

9 RS also was able to provide a screen shot of a video she was  
10 sent digitally through an application known as "Telegram" of  
11 Richards also being penetrated by Diamond. She recognized the  
12 location shown in the screen shot as her apartment in  
13 Bellevue, WA.

14  
15 On 10/25/2017, I met with King County Prosecutors and RS at  
16 the King County Prosecutor's Office. RS detailed the  
17 information above, correcting the date that the dog Diamond  
18 was taken by Richards as being the week prior in May than the  
19 one she originally gave (May 31). She also advised she met  
20 Richards at a BBQ in August of 2016. They lived together  
21 throughout most of 2017 until the summer. She met Grabowsky  
22 in person in Chicago, IL at a "Furry" convention. They were  
23 introduced to each other by Richards. Richards and Grabowsky  
24 are friends. This is the only time she knows of that the dog  
25 would not have left her side. Diamond remains with her at  
26 almost all times as he alerts her to life threatening changes  
27 in her blood pressure. On that lone occasion in May she  
28 allowed Richards to take Diamond because she had not been  
29 leaving her home and knew the dog needed exercise. She was  
30 able to show us digital conversations that appear to

1 corroborate the domestic violence abuse as well as her  
2 friendship with Grabowsky.

3  
4 RS also detailed information that she, Richards and Grabowsky  
5 were all part of a large group of "Furry" enthusiasts. These  
6 are people that dress up as animals and socialize. Some of  
7 these people communicate and share media with each other on  
8 digital devices such as phones. This is how she was able to  
9 receive the video of her dog engaged in sex acts. She  
10 identified Grabowsky and Richards by "screenname" as well as  
11 others believed to have access to these images of animal  
12 cruelty. It is her belief and understanding that there is a  
13 group on Telegram app that share videos of themselves engaging  
14 in these crimes with each other. Telegram is an app that  
15 broadcasts in a manner that can either be live or recorded  
16 (one showing a screen in shape of circle, the other live  
17 broadcasts). This is how "Wade" would have been able to  
18 capture and send to RS.

19  
20 Grabowsky has further admitted to RS that he has sex with dogs  
21 and has an attraction for them. He has told her that he has  
22 sex with dogs refrain from having sex with underage girls. He  
23 has admitted to RS to having sex with his own dog, "Shadow".  
24 RS also heard through the "furry" group of friends that he  
25 was getting dogs from Facebook and then disposing of them  
26 (killing them) when he is done. When she confronted him about  
27 this Grabowsky told her that he gave the animal back to the  
28 seller when done.

**Unlawful Imprisonment - Domestic Violence**

1 RS detailed information regarding numerous domestic assaults  
2 that occurred at their old address, located at 15566 NE 22<sup>nd</sup>  
3 Pl, Bellevue (WA). RS said on the night on August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017,  
4 her and Richards were arguing in their apartment over the fact  
5 that she confronted them about Grabowsky sleeping with  
6 Diamond. During the argument, Richards grabbed Diamond and  
7 threatened to throw him off the balcony onto the street below.  
8 RS ran into another room to get away from Richards and held  
9 the door close. Richards forced the door open which hit RS in  
10 the face. Richards then grabbed RS by the shoulders and threw  
11 her to the ground. Richards immediately began hitting and  
12 slapping RS as she tried to protect herself by covering up her  
13 face. During the interview, RS played a recording she made  
14 during the part of the argument where Richards threatened to  
15 throw Diamond off the balcony.  
16

17  
18 RS explained there was another incident at the Bellevue  
19 apartment in 2017 where Richards forced her into the kitchen  
20 pantry and locking it because she would not have sex with him.  
21 After forcing her into the pantry, Richards left for work. RS  
22 was in the pantry for a few hours until she was let out by a  
23 roommate who had come home. Another incident in the Bellevue  
24 apartment occurred in the first week of August 2017, where  
25 Richards and RS were arguing again about her not wanting to  
26 have sex. In that incident, the argument ended up outside on  
27 the balcony where Richards grabbed RS and smashed her face  
28 into a door frame, causing her to have a black eye and  
29 injuries to her hand, wrist and left leg. Richards then  
30 locked RS outside on the balcony for approximately 30 minutes

1 until she managed to crawl into the master bedroom window. On  
2 03/08/2017, Richards and RS were arguing because RS refused to  
3 have sex with his friend. Richards was upset with RS and  
4 locked her outside on the seventh floor balcony for  
5 approximately 2-3 hours in the cold against her will.

6  
7 On 09/14/2017, I confirmed RS sent pictures of the injuries  
8 she sustained from Richards assaulting her (on 08/24/2017) to  
9 a friend of hers with the screen name "TrissPickle". I was  
10 able to get pictures of the messages/pictures she sent to  
11 "TrissPickle". Richards continues to violate the no-contact  
12 order even this week, sending messages by way of third party  
13 to RS.

14  
15 Extortion in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree (with Sexual Motivation and DV),  
16 Assault in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree - (with Sexual Motivation and DV)

17 On 07/27/2017, Richards was upset with RS because of money and  
18 finances. At that time, she had stopped engaging in sexual  
19 activities with him and had been for approximately 3-4 weeks.  
20 During the arguing, Richards told her that they could not  
21 afford to eat out. He told her that he was going to a company  
22 picnic and that he would bring some food home. When RS said  
23 she would get something to eat on her own, Richards insisted  
24 that RS wait until he returned home with food from the picnic  
25 and eat that instead. When Richards returned home, he gave RS  
26 a pulled pork BBQ sandwich which had pineapple BBQ sauce on it  
27 (RS is severely allergic to pineapple, it can cause a  
28 potentially fatal anaphylactic shock and Richards knows this,  
29 and knows). Richards left for work and within a few minutes  
30 of eating the sandwich, she started having an allergic

1 reaction to the pineapple BBQ sauce. RS text Richards to come  
2 home to take her to the hospital and at the same time, she  
3 began looking for her EpiPen(s). RS said she always keeps her  
4 EpiPens in a certain bathroom drawer but none of them were  
5 there. RS looked all over the apartment in all the rooms and  
6 drawers but was unable to find any.

7 When Richards arrived back at their Bellevue, WA  
8 apartment, he immediately produced an EpiPen in his hand and  
9 said "looking for these?" Richards refused to give RS the  
10 EpiPen, telling her something to the effect of "you know what  
11 I want and I know what you want. Let's make a trade." RS  
12 understood this Richards trying to force her to have sexual  
13 intercourse with him in exchange for her life-saving  
14 medication, the epi-pen. RS began feeling helpless and begged  
15 Richards for the EpiPen but he said no, telling her that she  
16 was going "to put out" and then he would give her the EpiPen.  
17 RS understood this to be a threat to harm her if she did not  
18 have sex with him. RS continued looking for an EpiPen and  
19 finally found one that expired in 2014. She administered the  
20 EpiPen and took some Benadryl to counteract the allergic  
21 reaction. Richards finally drove RS to Overlake Medical  
22 center and dropped her off at the emergency room and he went  
23 back to work. On 10/30/2017, I went to Overlake Medical  
24 Center and picked up Scott's medical records. I verified that  
25 she went to the emergency room and was treated for an allergic  
26 reaction on 07/27/2017. The notes on the medical records show  
27 that she "accidentally" was exposed to pineapple in a BBQ sauce  
28 and that she took an EpiPen and some Benadryl before going to  
29 the emergency room.


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1 As mentioned above, there is a no-contact order in place  
2 protecting RS from Richards. I have confirmed that the order  
3 is valid and he was served with notice of it. It was issued  
4 by the King County District Court, East Division - Bellevue on  
5 August 24, 2017 under cause number 7Z0123887 and signed by the  
6 defendant on that date. While meeting with RS at the Renton PD  
7 Detective Bureau, she showed me numerous private messages from
