Responding to the request of the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, for a Bill of Particulars, the Assistant Prosecutor says that the State of Ohio will prove on the trial of the above-entitled case, the following:

• **Count 1: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

• **Count 2: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

• **Count 3: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

• **Count 4: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

• **Count 5: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

- **Count 6: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

- **Count 7: Pandering Sexually-Oriented Matter Involving a Minor, 2907.322(A)(1)**

That on or about June 20, 2016 to April 21, 2017, and at the location of 170 W. Columbus St., Nelsonville, Athens County, Ohio, the Defendant, Cody Layne Prater, did, with knowledge of the character of the material or performance involved, create, record, photograph, film, develop, reproduce, or publish material that shows a minor participating or engaging in sexual activity, masturbation, or bestiality contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.
